Year 8

Opal Coast

Usually takes place in June. Rough cost £500 which includes transport, full board and lodging, insurance and all visits.

We will stay on the coast near Le Touquet for 4 nights, Monday to Friday. This is a beautiful area of northern France with lovely beaches and charming villages. Each day will be spent visiting the local area and attractions such as a traditional bakery where we have a go at making bread, a snail farm (with tasting!), the largest aquarium in Europe and the market in the old town of Boulogne where students will have the chance to practise their French. Travel is by coach and Eurotunnel.

Rhineland

Usually takes place in June. Rough cost £550 which includes transport, full board and lodging, insurance and all visits.

We will stay on the Rhine in Boppard for 4 nights, Monday to Thursday. This is a beautiful area of western Germany, full of history and culture. Each day will be spent visiting the local area and attractions such as a medieval castle, the historic and charming Old Town of Koblenz, a theme park and a river cruise on the Rhine. Travel is by coach and Eurotunnel.

Seville

In KS3, students studying Spanish are given the opportunity of a 5 day residential trip to Seville. Not only does this allow them experience all of the sites of one of the most famous cities in Spain, it also allows them to experience and enjoy the culture in a far more meaningful way. As part of the experience, students will not only have guided tours of Tapas restaurants, the Royal Palace and the famous sites of the city, they also get to experience the delights of the most famous festival in Spain - the Fería de Abríl, have lessons in Flamenco dancing and even get lessons on Spanish cookery, learning how and preparing their very own Paella. The trip is scheduled to take place at the end of April, when the weather is perfect and comes in at approximately £770 but this does include everything including the return flights.

Hunstanton Fieldtrip

During the spring/ summer term of Year 8, pupils have the opportunity to visit Hunstanton on the Norfolk coast for a day trip. Activities for the day include: Coastal based fieldwork on the beach (beach profiling, evaluating the usefulness of coastal sea defences), alongside a visit to the sea life centre. Estimated cost of the trip: £30-£40

Rosslyn Park

From its humble beginning in 1939, the Rosslyn ParkNational Schools Sevens has evolved into the world's largest school rugby tournament with over 10,000 boys and girls aged 11 - 18 competing annually. The trip involves an overnight stay in London, often at the Chessington World of Adventure hotel, followed by a full day's rugby, with the older age groups competing for a place in the finals on the second day
